**Facilities and Amenities**

**Location**

The Sonnenalp Resort of Vail is located in the heart of Vail Village at 20 Vail Road, Vail, Colorado 81657. It is 30 miles from the Vail/Eagle County Airport and 100 miles from Denver International Airport via I-70.

**Hotel**

Valet parking is a complimentary service for hotel guests. A warm and elegant lobby welcomes visitors from around the world. Many of the watercolors on display in the hotel are dramatic Native American scenes painted by

Julius Seyler, a well-known German Artist from the late 1800's. The Faessler Family acquired the art for the hotel

because it symbolized the blending of European tradition with the spirit of the West.

**Bed Base:**

**88 Suites, 2 Hotel Guest Rooms**

Remodeled in 1993, each suite has a balcony overlooking either the village or the mountain, gas-log fireplace, fully-stocked mini-bar, walk-in closet, king or double bed with a down comforter, custom-designed Bavarian furniture and entertainment center with web-based television offering high speed internet access. Grand-scale bathrooms feature a soaking tub and heated marble floors. Plush terry robes, irons and ironing boards and hair dryers are provided in every room.

**Restaurants & Lounges**

**Ludwig's** - An elegant, award-winning restaurant serving contemporary American cuisine with a French influence. Ludwig's is well known in the valley for its elegant European-style breakfast buffet.

Hours: Dinner from 6 p.m. to 10 p.m. Tuesday through Sunday; breakfast buffet served daily from 6 a.m. to 11 a.m.

**Bully Ranch** - Casual, family-style dining featuring American and Southwestern dishes. The Bully Ranch bar is a local's favorite offering a variety of imported and regional beers as well as the popular "Mud Slide."

Hours: Open daily; from 11 a.m. to 11 p.m.

**King's Club** - Apres Ski is served from 3:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. daily during the ski season. This comfortable lounge next to the lobby is an easy gathering place for live entertainment from 8:00 to midnight year round.

**Balata** – In the clubhouse of the Sonnenalp Golf Club, Balata epitomizes “true American cooking” with a relaxed atmosphere and outside decks that take full advantage of spectacular mountain and valley views. Spike’s Pub at Balata offers a light menu and a bountiful assortment of micro brews and wines by the glass.

**Spa:** The Sonnenalp Resort of Vail is known throughout the region for its elegant European-style spa. A relaxed seating area surrounds the fireplace. A spa menu is offered as well as a full range of beverages. Facilities include nine treatment rooms; luxurious locker room, sauna, steam, indoor and outdoor Jacuzzis, indoor/outdoor pool and relaxation areas. An extensive choice of spa treatments is offered and administered by experienced therapists and aestheticians using the most modern equipment and technology.

The fitness facility offers the latest cardio and weight training equipment including Stairmaster™ 4000 stair climbers, LifeCycle™ exercise bicycles, LifeSlides™ treadmills, Gravitron™ resistance equipment and full range of free weights. Complimentary classes, including water aerobics, yoga and stretching are regularly scheduled. Personal trainers are also available.

**Library:** An array of daily newspapers from around the country plus best-selling novels from the New York Times list can be found in this relaxing and cozy library adjacent to the King’s Club lounge and Ludwig’s restaurant.

**Meetings:** Banquet and convention facilities include seven meeting rooms offering between 293 and 4,265 square feet of flexible, comfortable meeting space. Accommodating up to 200 people, the resort’s on-site catering and convention specialists plan and execute meetings, weddings and banquets with exceptional quality down to the last detail. **The Sonnenalp Golf Club:**

The award-winning Sonnenalp Golf Club maintains a private membership base of 250 members and makes tee times available to hotel guests as well as the public. The 18-hole links-style golf course, regarded as the best in the valley, is supported by a pro shop, extensive practice area, four tennis courts, outdoor pools and hot tubs, and fitness center and locker facility. The club’s restaurant, Balata, is a popular gathering spot for lunch and dinner and private parties. The Sonnenalp Golf Club is located at 1265 Berry Creek Road in Edwards, Colorado, 13 miles west of the hotel on I-70.

**Ski equipment rental and storage**

Hotel guests can store their ski equipment in complimentary air-circulating lockers at the Mountain Adventure Center located next to the Vista Bahn, the main ski lift out of Vail Village. The Sonnenalp Ski Shop located just across the porte cochere from the lobby, offers adult ski rentals and accessories as well as snowshoes and cross-country skis. The Sonnenalp Ski Shop staff transports rentals to and from the Mountain Adventure Center at daily for hotel guests.

**Guest Cars**

Guests of the Sonnenalp may request the use of the hotel's Lexus sedans or 4-wheel drive luxury utility vehicles for transportation needs during their stay.
